## INFORMATION CORNER

**Holy Week** is approaching. Please review the Mass schedule for Holy Week. The Parish office and the Franciscan Community Center will be closed on Good Friday, April 22nd, Easter Sunday, April 24th and Easter Monday, April 25th. The Parish office will re-open on Tuesday, April 26th. There will be only one Mass on Easter Monday, April 25th at 12 Noon in English. The Church will close immediately after the Mass.

The **Tenebrae** Service will be on Wednesday Evening April 20th at 7:30PM in the Main Church. On this evening, we will experience only a small portion of what Christ suffered on the day of his Crucifixion. **Tenebrae** is an evening of reflective music –both choral and congregational– interspersed with readings from scripture and the Fathers of the Church, designed to speak symbolically of our lives, identified in the death and resurrection of Jesus.

**Holy Name School Easter** recess begins on Wednesday, April 20th. Classes resume on Monday, May 2nd. **Religious Education:** There will be no Religious Education classes on Easter Sunday, April 24th. Classes resume on Sunday, May 1st. On Sunday, May 8th, Mother's Day, there will be no classes.

## MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

**Children's Faith Formation:** Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. **Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome.**
