MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

Liturgical Ministry: Each of our Masses has a team that is responsible for ministering at the liturgy. Included on the team are Lectors, Ministers of Hospitality, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, Altar Servers. These ministries are open to all and provide an opportunity of sharing some of your time and talent with the community. Training is provided. If you would like more information, please contact the Parish Office.

Children's Faith Formation: Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. There are 30 classes each year and each class lasts 90 minutes. Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome. Education and certification is available for those who volunteer. Adult Faith Formation: The Adult Faith Formation Committee provides a wide variety of programs and experiences to renew and deepen the adult community at Holy Name in their love of the spirituality and sacramental life of the church.
