MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

Stewardship at Holy Name

The Church's rich Spirituality of Stewardship is the primary focus of our Parish Stewardship Committee. They meet periodically to discern how to bring the message of Stewardship to the men, women and children of Holy Name. The Committee's mission is to promote a conscious way of living that thanks God for all blessings received by returning a portion of them for the building of the Kingdom of God. The spirituality that supports this way of life is deeply studied, reflected upon and eventually implemented, both givers' and receivers' lives are changed and spiritually rewarded.

Through its presentations, projects and programs the Stewardship committee hopes to deepen parishioners' relations with Jesus Christ as it challenges itself and all members of the parish to more deeply invest in Holy Name through the intentional, planned and proportionate giving of a portion of their time, talent and treasure for the strengthening of the community of faith.

Holy Name School

Holy Name School is a Middle States accredited Catholic school with students attending pre-K through 8th Grades. The pre-K is Montessori-based. The school emphasizes the integration of state of the art technology into its curriculum. It uses Smart Boards in the classroom, has two computer labs and uses video conferencing for distance learning. The school was the recipient of the 2005 BLACKBOARD AWARD recognizing it as one of the most outstanding private elementary schools on the Upper Westside of Manhattan.

In addition to taking care of the academic needs of the students, Holy Name School places a strong emphasis on teaching values rooted in our Roman Catholic faith. Even though students are accepted from all faiths, basic Christian principles govern the actions of the children, faculty and staff. Respect for one another is a predominate theme throughout the day and all aspects of school life. Franciscan Community Center

One of the premier ministries of Holy Name Parish is the Franciscan Community Center. The center exists to serve the people of Manhattan's Upper West Side as an instrument of God's peace. In the spirit of St. Francis, we reach out to all, in particular the poor, the alienated and immigrant communities. We develop, manage and support educational, recreational and social programs that create positive change in the lives of those we serve. Volunteers are always needed for leading and assisting in our youth programs, and to help with our services to the neighborhood such as our food pantry, sandwich line, thrift store, etc. The Center is located at 214 West 97th Street. Liturgical Ministry: Each of our Masses has a team that is responsible for ministering at the liturgy. Included on the team are Lectors, Ministers of Hospitality, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, Altar Servers. These ministries are open to all and provide an opportunity of sharing some of your time and talent with the community. Training is provided. Children's Faith Formation: Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. There are 30 classes each year and each class lasts 90 minutes. Volunteers teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome. Education and certification is available for those who volunteer. Adult Faith Formation: The Adult Faith Formation Committee provides a wide variety of programs and experiences to renew and deepen the adult community at Holy Name in their love of the spirituality and sacramental life of the church.
