Through its presentations, projects and programs the Stewardship Committee hopes to deepen parishioners' relations with Jesus Christ as it challenges itself and all members of the parish to more deeply invest in Holy Name through the intentional, planned and proportionate giving of a portion of their time, talent and treasure for the strengthening of the community of faith.
