The New York Catholic Bible School

The New York Catholic Bible School offers adults the scriptural foundations of our Catholic faith. The Bible School, sponsored by the Catechetical Office, meets each year for three trimesters. A trimester is comprised of 10 sessions. The first year is devoted to the Hebrew Scriptures (Old Testament) and the second to the Christian Scriptures (New Testament). Each class and trimester builds on the one before, just as the Christian Scriptures are rooted in the Hebrew. The complete four-year course of study examines every book of the Bible.

The New York Archdiocese has announced that new classes are forming for September 2011. This is how classes are formed, according to the director of the New York Catholic Bible School, Anne Malloy. "Whenever we gather a minimum of 15 students in a specific area, we can form a new class. We already have a number of interested people throughout the archdiocese and expect to be forming classes for September 2011." This course of Scripture study is highly recommended!
