### Religious Education Registration for 2014-2015

Registration forms are also available in the Parish Office. The Religious Education Program is open to children from kindergarten through eighth grade who are in public, private or independent schools. **Classes begin Sunday, September 7, 2014.**

**Children's Faith Formation:** Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. There are 30 classes each year and each class lasts 90 minutes. Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome. Education and certification is available for those who volunteer. 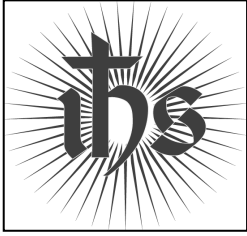
