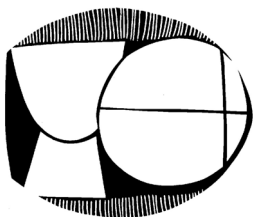

Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. There are 30 classes each year and each class lasts 90 minutes. **INFORMATIONS AU SUJET DES PERES LAWRENCE ET KEVIN**

**Père Lawrence Hayes, OFM**

Né à Franklin Square, Long Island, (New York). Ses parents sont New Yorkais de naissance. Il est le quatrième de 5 frères qui vivent aux Etats Unis . Etant donné que Père Larry a fréquenté les écoles primaires, secondaires et le collège à Manhattan, sa nomination à la 96<sup>e</sup> rue est en quelque sorte un retour au foyer pour lui. «C'est bon d'être de retour à la maison » dit-il. Consacré prêtre en 1989, le père Larry a travaillé pendant 25 ans dans des paroisses hispaniques et multiculturelles, et parle couramment l'Espagnol.
