Fr. Lawrence Hayes, O.F.M.

Fr. Lawrence Hayes (Larry) was born in Franklin Square, Long Island (NY). Both his parents were native New Yorkers. He is the fourth of 5 brothers who now live across the U.S. As Fr. Larry attended high school and college in Manhattan, his assignment to 96th Street is somewhat a "homecoming" for him. "It's good to be home again," he notes. Ordained in 1989, Fr. Larry has worked for 25 years in Hispanic and multicultural parishes and is fluent in Spanish. Most recently he was pastor at Immaculate Conception parish in Durham, N.C. In parish ministry, Fr. Larry particularly enjoys involvement in adult education--RCIA, Bible studies, etc.--and providing spiritual direction. Fr. Larry looks forward to serving at Holy Name and getting to know the parishioners here. "I'm already quite impressed by the diversity in the parish and moved by the friendliness of the folks as they leave Mass. It doesn't take long to feel at home at Holy Name!"
