## MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

### Stewardship at Holy Name

The Church's rich Spirituality of Stewardship is the primary focus of our Parish Stewardship Committee. They meet periodically to discern how to bring the message of Stewardship to the men, women and children of Holy Name. The Committee's mission is to promote a conscious way of living that thanks God for all blessings received by returning a portion of them for the building of the Kingdom of God. The spirituality that supports this way of life is deeply studied, reflected upon and eventually implemented, both givers' and receivers' lives are changed and spiritually rewarded. Through its presentations, projects and programs the Stewardship committee hopes to deepen parishioners' relations with Jesus Christ as it challenges itself and all members of the parish to more deeply invest in Holy Name through the intentional, planned and proportionate giving of a portion of their time, talent and treasure for the strengthening of the community of faith.

**Children's Faith Formation:** Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. **Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome.**

If your child is between the ages of 5 and 17 and has not receive the Sacrament of Baptism and would like to register for classes, there is still time to do so. For more information, contact Veronica Soto, Director of Faith Formation at 212-749-0276 ext. 116.

Baptisms are celebrated in French on the first Sunday of the month, English on the second and Spanish on the third. Parents and Godparents are asked to participate in a Baptism Preparation Program prior to their child's Baptism.

**Marriage:** To schedule your wedding and/or register for our Marriage Preparation Program, please call the Parish Office at least six months prior to your anticipated date.

**Reconciliation:** Tuesday and Thursday 11:30 A.M. – 12:00 P.M, Saturday 4:00 P.M. – 5:00 P.M. in English and Spanish or anytime by appointment through the Parish Office.

**Sacrament of the Sick:** If you or a loved one are ill or hospitalized, please contact the Parish Office to arrange for home, convalescent or hospital visitation and celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick.

**Eucharistic Adoration:** First Friday of the month from 12:30 P.M. – 1:30 P.M.

### Pastoral Care to the Homebound and Infirm

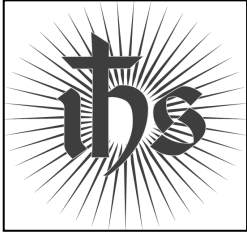
