President's Day



Monday, February 15th is President's Day, a Federal Holiday. There will be one Mass at 9:00am (English). The Church will be closed immediately after the Mass. The parish office and the Franciscan Community Center will also be closed on this day.

Ash Wednesday, February 17th Ashes will be blessed and distributed at all the Masses 7:00AM, 9:00AM (Spanish), 12:00PM and please note that there will be a 7:00PM Mass on this day. Ashes will also be distributed throughout the day until after the 7:00PM Mass. **Stations of The Cross** every Friday during The Lenten Season. Please join us after the 12 noon Mass beginning Friday, February 19th .

Fast and Abstinence-During the Season of Lent, the Church urges all the Faithful to reflect a spirit in penance in their daily life through performing acts of fast and abstinence.

FASTING requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to obliges until age 59. Those not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.

ABSTINENCE prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout their entire life. Those not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are encouraged to join in this discipline to the extent that they are able. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

Holy Name School will be closed for winter recess on Monday, February 15th and will resume classes on Monday, February 22nd.
