MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

Adult Education: The Adult Faith Formation Committee provides effective programs to renew and deepen the adult community's love of the spirituality of our Catholic faith and its sacramental beliefs. Through prayerful exploration we offer specific topical study, parish lectures and opportunities for prayer and reflection for liturgical seasons and feasts. The *schedule of this year's Adult Faith Formation Series* is available on the Welcome Table in the vestibule of the church or on our website at www.holynamenc.org.

Children's Faith Formation: Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. **Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome.**

Liturgical Ministry: Each of our masses has a team that is responsible for ministering at the liturgy. Included on the team are Lectors, Ministers of Hospitality, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, Altar Servers. These ministries are open to all and provide an opportunity of sharing some of your time and talent with the community. Training is provided. Peace, Justice and Integrity of Creation: This committee provides educational programs and service opportunities for the members of the parish. The committee works closely with our neighboring churches and the Franciscan Province of the Holy Name in exploring the wide range of issues of peace, social justice and the environment. **To become involved in this important ministry or to receive more information, please contact Janet Curley at 646-591-4022.**
