RCIA MEMBERS ATTEND RITE OF ELECTION

*"Fear not, for I have redeemed you;
I have called you by name and you are mine" (Isaiah 43,1)*

Seven members of the English, French, Creole and Spanish RCIA will be sent today, February 21st after the homily to attend the **Rite of Election** at the Cathedral of St. Patrick. These catechumens who are preparing for Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist join all the other catechumens of the New York Archdiocese to celebrate this important step. At this ceremony, also known as the **Enrollment of Names**, the catechumens are presented by the parish representative to Archbishop Dolan as sincere in their desire to be initiated into the sacramental life of the Church. Their godparents and RCIA team members attend with them and testify that these catechumens are desirous of receiving the Sacraments of Christian Initiation. All the community agrees to support them in faith, prayer and example.

At the Cathedral each catechumen is **called forward by name** and inscribes her or his name in the **Book of the Elect** of this archdiocese. As the **elect chosen by God** they then continue their preparation for the reception of the sacraments at the Easter Vigil on April 3rd, 2010.

We congratulate **Claire Husson, Samuel Lopez, Luz Maximino, Titina Nadege, Papoute Ouedraogo, Lefevre Surpris, and Kabore Thiombiano!** Pray to the Lord for them, their families and the RCIA team that we may be renewed and share the joys of Easter.
