Under the Institute for Leadership's Healthcare Reform Initiative Faith Fights Diabetes' mission is to equip those who have been identified as high risk for diabetes and those with diabetes with the tools to live a healthier and longer lives.

The Institute of Leadership (IFL) has developed a six week class to help people prevent and manage diabetes.
