Children's Faith Formation: Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. **Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome.**

LITURGICAL MINISTRY: Each of our Masses has a team that is responsible for ministering at the liturgy. Included on the team are Lectors, Ministers of Hospitality, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, Altar Servers. These ministries are open to all and provide an opportunity of sharing some of your time and talent with the community. Training is provided. **Faith Fights Diabetes
At the
Franciscan Community Center**

Under the Institute for Leadership's Healthcare Reform Initiative Faith Fights Diabetes' mission is to equip those who have been identified as high risk for diabetes and those with diabetes with the tools to live a healthier and longer lives.

The Institute of Leadership (IFL) has developed a six week class to help people prevent and manage diabetes. The class would be **free** for anyone who registers and participates in the six week program, every Thursday, starting **February 2, 2012**. These classes will provide participants with the knowledge of how to:

- Class 1 "Know Your Numbers"
What is diabetes, risk factors, and the ABC's
- Class 2 "Reduce Your Numbers"
Diet, portion size, carbohydrates, and label reading
- Class 3 "Manage Your Numbers"
Emotional eating, exercise, stress journaling and prayer
- Classes 4,5,6 "Support Group Sessions"
Track progress, testimonies and goals encouragement
