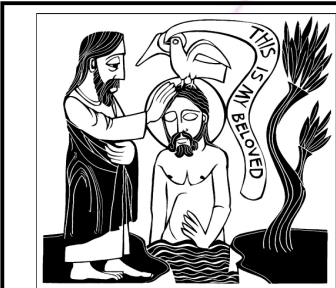

CELL PHONES FOR SOLDIERS PROGRAM:

Do you have any old cell phones lying around? The donation of them to the *Cell Phones for Soldiers Program* helps raise money for prepaid calling cards that enable our soldiers to stay connected with their families without incurring expensive phone charges. Money for phone cards is raised by selling used cell phones and accessories to a company that refurbishes them for resale. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome.

Adult Education: The Adult Faith Formation Committee provides effective programs to renew and deepen the adult community's love of the spirituality of our Catholic faith and its sacramental beliefs. Through prayerful exploration we offer specific topical study, parish lectures and opportunities for prayer and reflection for liturgical seasons and feasts. Peace, Justice and Integrity of Creation: This committee provides educational programs and service opportunities for the members of the parish.
