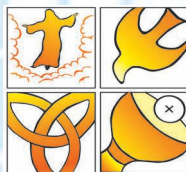

Marriage: To schedule your wedding and/or register for our Marriage Preparation Program, please call the Parish Office at least six months prior to your anticipated date.

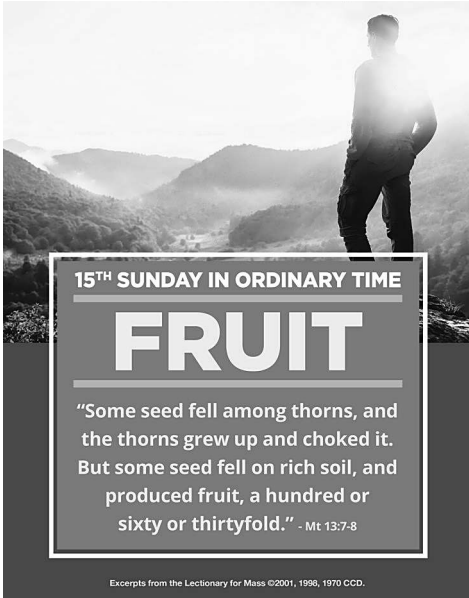

ALL ARE WELCOME

On behalf of my Franciscan brothers, our pastoral staff and our entire community, it's my pleasure to welcome you to Holy Name-St. Gregory Parish. We are delighted that you have chosen our faith community as your place of worship and of belonging. Our parish family dates back to 1865 when the first Mass was celebrated for some five hundred folks who gathered in a cramped, wooden structure on 96th Street. Now our "Cathedral of the Upper West Side" is home to a richly diverse group of people, representing over fifty nations, who gather each weekend united in the story of Jesus, to pray the Lord's Prayer, to turn and embrace one another, and to share in the nourishment of the Eucharist. "Hear then the parable of the sower." With his analogy of the sower and the seed, Jesus gives us four images to help us gauge the depth of our spiritual maturity. What kind of "soil" does our faith exist in? Are we fruitful Christians? Does our seed yield as much as it could?

The first image is of the seed that fell on the path. This describes those who hear about Christianity "without understanding it." Nothing can grow, nothing can blossom at this level. We should ask ourselves if we have taken the time to be sure we understand the faith we practice. Are we stuck at a superficial level, allowing stereotypes, popular opinion or media distortions to "steal away" the richness of the Catholic faith?

Perhaps we have been properly educated in the teachings of the faith but our commitment has been fickle. Are we the seed on the rocky ground that "has no root and lasts only for a time"? Have we experienced difficulties in the practice of our faith that have led us to become indifferent? Have we found it just too troublesome to bring our faith into our everyday lives?

Or have we heard the word but allowed it to be choked by "worldly anxiety and the lure of riches"? Do we appreciate Christianity but fail to make the sacrifices that it requires? Are we more interested in a comfortable life than anything else?

Many of us have sampled these stages at different times. But ultimately our goal as Christians is to be "the seed sown on rich soil." We are called to be open to hearing the word, to seek to understand it and to allow it to take firm root in our hearts. When we do this the seed of our own faith can produce a rich harvest for the world.

La palabra de Dios es inmensamente rica en misericordia, nos lo demuestra la primera lectura de hoy, motivándonos a la confianza en ella; el fin, lo explica muy claro, es dar fruto en la vida al escucharla. El profeta Isaías compara la palabra de Dios con la lluvia y la nieve que empapa la tierra y la hace germinar. La esperanza es que cada vez que se escucha la palabra empape el corazón hasta que un día dé fruto y lo dé en abundancia. "Así será la palabra que sale de mi boca: no volverá a mí sin resultado sino que hará mi voluntad y cumplirá su misión" (Is 55, 11).

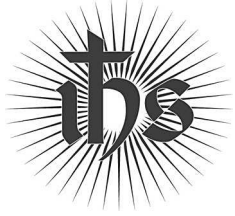

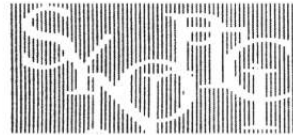
