Reconciliation: Tuesday and Thursday 11:30 AM–12:00 PM, Saturday 4:00 PM–5:00 PM in English and Spanish or anytime by appointment through the Parish Office.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you or a loved one are ill or hospitalized, please contact the Parish Office to arrange for home, convalescent or hospital visitation and celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick.

MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

LITURGICAL MINISTRY: Each of our Masses has a team that is responsible for ministering at the liturgy. Included on the team are Lectors, Ministers of Hospitality, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, Altar Servers. These ministries are open to all and provide an opportunity of sharing some of your time and talent with the community. Training is provided. PEACE, JUSTICE AND INTEGRITY OF CREATION: This committee provides educational programs and service opportunities for the members of the parish.
