RCIA MEMBERS ATTEND RITE OF ELECTION

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Five members of the English and Spanish RCIA groups will be sent today, March 13th, after the homily to attend the **Rite of Election** at the Cathedral of St. Patrick.

These catechumens who are preparing for Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist join all the other catechumens of the New York Archdiocese to celebrate this important step. At this ceremony, also known as the **Enrollment of Names**, the catechumens are presented by the parish representative to Archbishop Dolan as sincere in their desire to be initiated into the sacramental life of the Church. Their godparents and RCIA team members attend with them and testify that these catechumens are desirous of receiving the Sacraments of Christian Initiation. All the community agrees to support them in faith, prayer and example.

At the Cathedral each catechumen is **called forward by name** and inscribes her or his name in the **Book of the Elect** of this archdiocese. As the **"Elect," those chosen by God**, they then continue their preparation for the reception of the sacraments at the Easter Vigil on April 23rd, 2011.
