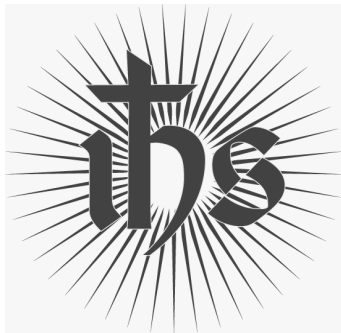

OUR PARISH CELEBRATES THE THIRD LENTEN SCRUTINY

Today, March 17, 2013 we celebrate the Third Lenten Scrutiny with the Elect—those preparing for Baptism, Confirmation and First Eucharist at the Easter Vigil on March 30th, 2013. The purpose of the Scrutinies is to “uncover and then to heal all that is weak, defective and sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out and then to strengthen all that is upright, strong and good.” As we pray for them we ask God to do exactly the same thing for us!

Cycle A readings are always used because of the significance of the Gospel passage. John's Gospel reading of the Raising of Lazarus from the Dead (Jn 11:1-45) asks of all of us, what do we need to bring to God for restoration or renewal at this time?

Spend some time in prayer for our RCIA members this week. Pray also for the courage to look honestly into your own heart. What needs to be healed and what needs to be strengthened in your own life?

“God of life, through your Spirit Who gives life, fill us with faith, hope and charity that we may live with you always in the glory of your resurrection, for You are Lord for ever and ever. Amen.”
