Holy Name Church's Tenebrae Service *Wednesday Evening, March 31 at 7:30 pm*



A Note About Tenebrae

This service of worship is taken from an early Christian service called Tenebrae. The name *Tenebrae* is a Latin word meaning "darkness" or "shadow".

On this evening, we will experience only a small portion of what Christ suffered on the day of his Crucifixion. One of the most conspicuous features of the service is the gradual extinguishing of candles until only a single candle, considered a symbol of our Lord, remains. As it gets darker and darker, we can reflect on Jesus' leaving His life here on earth. Toward the end of the service, the Christ candle is hidden. For a brief time, long enough for the Lord's Prayer, we remain in darkness, meditating on the mystery of Christ's death and the apparent victory of darkness and evil in our lives.

At the very end, a loud noise, the *strepitus*, is made symbolizing the earthquake at the time of Jesus' death and His resurrection ...the conquest of good over evil. The Christ candle is then brought back into view. By its light we pray, then leave quietly, anticipating the events to unfold in the Sacred Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil.

Here, Tenebrae is an evening of reflective music - both choral and congregational - interspersed with readings from scripture and the Fathers of the Church, designed to speak symbolically of our lives, identified in the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Weekly Collection: The total collection for last weekend was \$9,243.61. The second collection for next weekend, Sunday, March 28th will be for Flowers and Decoration. This collection will help have the Church prepared for Holy Week. Thank you for your continued support.
