Our Mission Statement

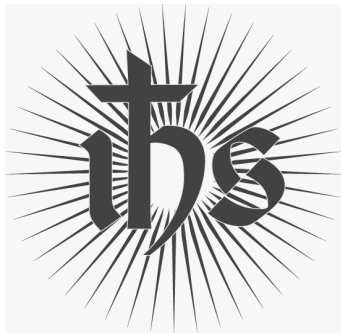

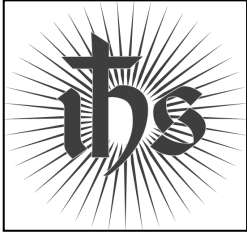
