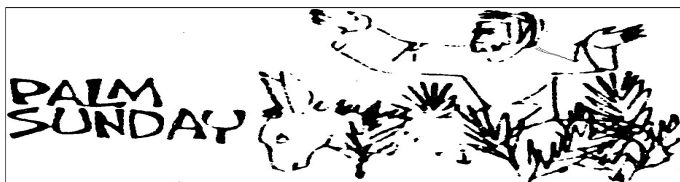

Stewardship Moment

Passion Sunday

It is always difficult to hear the Passion narrative. Yet we see in Jesus' passion something that is at the heart of discipleship and stewardship – **trust**. Jesus' anxiety in the garden turns into trust, "*yet, not my will but yours be done.*" Good stewards set aside pride and fear and trust in God's plan for their lives. Pray for wisdom, so that you may know how God wants you to use and share the gift of your life. There is an intense joy and peace of mind that can only be found in doing the will of God.

Reminder: Holy Week is approaching. Please review the Mass schedule for Holy Week. The Parish office and the Franciscan Community Center will be closed on Good Friday, April 2nd, Easter Sunday, April 4th and Easter Monday, April 5th. The Parish office will be open on Saturday, April 3rd from 9AM to 3PM. There will be only one Mass on Easter Monday, April 5th at 12 Noon in English. The Church will close immediately after the Mass.

The Tenebrae Service will be on Wednesday Evening March 31st at 7:30PM in the Main Church. On this evening, we will experience only a small portion of what Christ suffered on the day of his Crucifixion. Tenebrae is an evening of reflective music –both choral and congregational– interspersed with readings from scripture and the Fathers of the Church, designed to speak symbolically of our lives, identified in the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Holy Name School Easter recess begins on Wednesday, March 31st . Classes resume on Monday, April 12th.

Religious Education: There will be no Religious Education Classes on Easter Sunday, April 4th. Classes resume on Sunday, April 11th .

Weekly Collection: The total collection for last weekend was **\$9,853.00**. The second collection for next weekend, Sunday, April 4 will be your Easter gift. Thank you for your continued support.
