MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

Children's Faith Formation: Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. **Volunteer teachers and assistants are needed and always welcome.**

Music Ministry: We have five active choirs in the parish. Joining one of the choirs is a great way to get involved in parish life and networks you with a social community that is made up of friends and neighbors from all five boroughs. So consider participating in one of our choirs:

9:00 A.M.: Children's Choir
10:30 A.M.: Spanish Choir
1:30 P.M.: French Choir
5:30 P.M.: Contemporary Choir

All choirs sing on Sunday, from September through early June. Additional liturgies are sung for Christmas, Holy Week and Easter. Rehearsals are just before each Sunday Mass, with the exception of the French choir, which rehearses on Saturdays. Peace, Justice and Integrity of Creation: This committee provides educational programs and service opportunities for the members of the parish. We engage in social, spiritual and service activities that build community among ourselves and to strengthen our relationship with God.
