MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

Liturgical Ministry: Each of our Masses has a team that is responsible for ministering at the liturgy. Included on the team are Lectors, Ministers of Hospitality, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, Altar Servers. These ministries are open to all and provide an opportunity of sharing some of your time and talent with the community. Training is provided. Children's Faith Formation: Our Religious Education programs are designed to provide for the faith formation and spiritual development of children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Children also receive preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Eucharist in the third grade and Confirmation in the ninth grade. The program includes instruction in small classes, retreats and other experiences throughout the year. There are 30 classes each year and each class lasts 90 minutes. THE biggest forum for sex trafficking of under-age girls and coerced women in the United States appears to be a Web site called backpage.com. According to the trade organization AIM Group, Backpage has 70 percent of the market for prostitution ads. Backpage is owned by an opaque private company called Village Voice Media. The ultimate owners turn out to be a handful of private financiers...Goldman Sachs, who sold their shares after being contacted by Mr. Kristof; Alta Communications, whose founder, William Egan, is also the owner of the Boston Celtics; and Brynwood Partners, which also owns famous brands like Balance Bar, Pretzle Flipz and Turtle. In one recent case in New York City, a 15-year old girl was drugged, tied up, raped and sold to johns through Backpage and other sites. Closing down the leading Web site used by traffickers would complicate their lives and hold the owners of Backpage accountable.
