ATTENTION: SUMMER MASS SCHEDULE



As summer approaches, we remind you that the times of our weekend masses will **NOT CHANGE**.

Beginning on Monday, May 28, Memorial Day, **ALL WEEKDAY MASSES**, including the 9:00am on Saturday, will be celebrated in the air-conditioned lower chapel. Beginning on June 2, the 5:30pm vigil mass on Saturday afternoon, the Sunday noon mass, and the 5:30pm mass on Sunday afternoon will be celebrated in the lower chapel. The 9:00am, 10:30am and the 1:30pm Sunday masses will NOT move but will continue to be celebrated in the Upper Church.

The Upper Church will be open its usual hours throughout the summer for private prayer and devotion. The Blessed Sacrament will be reserved in both the church and the chapel. We also remind you that the lower chapel is accessible by either stairs or by an electronic lift that was installed several years ago.

MINISTRIES AT HOLY NAME

Liturgical Ministry: Each of our Masses has a team that is responsible for ministering at the liturgy.
