Peace, Justice and Integrity of Creation: This committee provides educational programs and service opportunities for the members of the parish. THE biggest forum for sex trafficking of under-age girls and coerced women in the United States appears to be a Web site called Backpage.com. According to the trade organization AIM Group, Backpage has 70 percent of the market for prostitution ads. Backpage is owned by an opaque private company called Village Voice Media. The ultimate owners turn out to be a handful of private financiers...Goldman Sachs, who sold their shares after being contacted by Mr. Kristof; Alta Communications, whose founder, William Egan, is also the owner of the Boston Celtics; and Brynwood Partners, which also owns famous brands like Balance Bar, Pretzle Flipz and Turtle. In one recent case in New York City, a 15-year old girl was drugged, tied up, raped and sold to johns through Backpage and other sites. Closing down the leading Web site used by traffickers would complicate their lives and hold the owners of Backpage accountable.

NEW OUTREACH for UNEMPLOYED PERSONS

St. Francis of Assisi Church is starting a new series of weekly meetings to assist unemployed persons looking for a job. *The nine Saturday morning meetings start Saturday, May 12th, 10:00 am to 11:30 am* at St. Francis House—135 West 31st St (between 6th & 7th Ave) in Manhattan. There is no fee.

Participants will conduct their own, self-directed job search. The meetings will be based on two ideas—*encouragement* and *expectation*.

At the meetings, each participant tells what he or she did the previous week to get a job. Other participants offer feedback, *encouragement* and suggestions. At the end of each meeting, each participant states a job-search goal, task or action they have decided to accomplish during the coming week—with the *expectation* they will report their results at the next meeting.
