**From the US Bishops' Pastoral Letter,**

*Stewardship, A Disciple's Response*

Our culture frequently encourages us to focus on ourselves and our pleasures. At times we can find it far too easy to ignore spiritual realities and to deny our faith a role in shaping our life and decisions. As Catholics in America, we know what it is to struggle against selfishness and greed.

**For Parents**

Parents have a work of great importance. Within the family, they must introduce their children to the practice of stewardship – a challenging task in the face of today's widespread consumerism and individualism. Above all, it requires that parents themselves be models of good stewardship, especially by their selfless service to one another, to their children, and to their church and their community.

**Living Stewardship Together**

Discuss together your family's lifestyle and patterns of consumption (including the use of television and other media). Do any adjustments need to be made in order to be more intentional stewards of God's blessings, to move toward consuming only what you need?

**For Children**

At Christmas, birthdays, and other "gift-giving" occasions, we sometimes focus too much on all the things we want. Can you cut back on what you hope to get at those times, and focus more on how grateful you are for the things you will receive and for the people who give you those gifts? It's good stewardship!
