Our Parish Celebrates the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome

On Sunday October 14, 2012 at the 12 Noon Mass our parish will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome of the inquirers and candidates presently in the process of Christian Initiation of Adults—the RCIA. We joyfully accept into our parish community those inquirers who desire to be baptized into our Christian faith at the Easter Vigil. They are Melanie Mann and William Rivera. They are signed on their senses with the Sign of the Cross that Christ will strengthen them with the sign of His love. We also welcome those candidates who are already baptized and will complete their initiation into the Roman Catholic faith by the reception of the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist. They are Amy Frost, Tammy Lassiter, Shelany Maldonado, and Meredith Spivey.

All parishioners are encouraged to join in this Rite of Acceptance and Welcome. The RCIA inquirers as of yet not baptized officially enter the period of the Catechumenate, several months of intense preparation. Those already baptized continue the process of “continuing conversion.”

We congratulate all of them in taking this important step within their faith journey. They are as much a blessing for our parish as a new baby is to a family! We praise and thank God for the gift of growth and increase. The RCIA members and team ask all our parishioners to keep us in prayer as we continue our journey of faith in Jesus Christ. Thank you!

RCIA CATECHIST FORMATION TRAINING DAYS: The Archdiocese invites RCIA catechists to an RCIA Methodology, a level one catechist formation course for a total of five sessions over two Saturdays: October 27, 2012 and November 3, 2012 from 10am to 4pm in the Franciscan Community Center, entrance on west 97th Street between Broadway and Amsterdam Ave. There is no charge for these two days.

The Course will offer a basic understanding of the history, purpose and order of the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults and will explain the basic purpose of RCIA along with the ministerial and pastoral formation that are necessary to fully implement the Catechumenate in the parish. Participants will experience some of the rites, learn how to conduct a catechetical session and have a better sense of serving in the RCIA.
