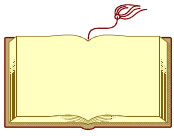

During the month of November we traditionally focus our attention on our deceased family members and friends. Here at Holy Name Church we will have an **Altar of Remembrance** dedicated to all the departed.

In preparation for this altar please bring to the church office any **copies of photographs** of your loved ones who have died. These photos (copies—no originals, please) may be in inexpensive frames, or they can be displayed on the poster boards.

In addition, we will have a **Book of Remembrance** in which you may write the names of the deceased whom you wish to remember. The Book and all the photos will be available during the entire month of November. **All are welcome to bring photos and/or enter names into the book.**

As a community of faith we will remember all who have passed on before us. We pray that all the departed, here at home, and throughout the world, will be blessed with eternal life forever in Heaven. "We believe in the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen."

Reminder that the Altar of Remembrance dedicated to all the departed will be placed at the St. Anne's altar. Bring photographs of those being remembered to the parish office by **Friday, October 29th.**

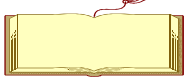

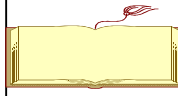
