RITE OF ACCEPTANCE AND WELCOME

On Sunday October 10, 2010 at the 12 Noon Mass our parish will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome of the inquirers and candidates presently in the process of Christian Initiation of Adults, the RCIA. We joyfully accept into our parish community those inquirers who desire to be baptized into our Christian faith at the Easter Vigil and welcome those candidates who are already baptized and will complete their initiation into the Roman Catholic faith by the reception of the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist.

All parishioners are encouraged to join in this Rite of Acceptance and Welcome. The RCIA inquirers officially enter the period of the Catechumenate, several months of intense preparation. Those already baptized continue the process of "continuing conversion." We congratulate all of them in taking this important step within their faith journey. They are as much a blessing for our parish as a new baby is to a family! We praise and thank God for the gift of growth and increase. All the RCIA members and the team ask our parishioners to keep us in prayer as we all continue our journey of faith in Jesus Christ. Thank you!
