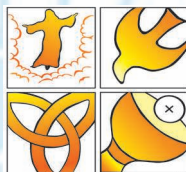

Baptism: Arrangements for Baptism should be made one month in advance. To schedule, please visit the Parish Office or call 212-749-0276, ext. 110 for more information. Baptisms are celebrated in French on the first Sunday of the month, English on the second and Spanish on the third. Parents and Godparents are asked to participate in a Baptism Preparation Program prior to their child's Baptism. The next English Baptism will be on Sunday, **November 12, 2017.**

Marriage: To schedule your wedding and/or register for our Marriage Preparation Program, please call the Parish Office at least six months prior to your anticipated date.

Reconciliation: Tuesday and Thursday 11:30 AM–12:00 PM, Saturday 4:00 PM–5:00 PM in English and Spanish or anytime by appointment through the Parish Office.

Sacrament of the Sick: If you or a loved one is ill or hospitalized, please contact the Parish Office to arrange for home, convalescent or hospital visitation and celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick.

Eucharistic Adoration: First Friday of the month from 12:30 P.M. – 1:30 P.M. Adoration will resume on the 6th of October.

ALTAR OF REMEMBRANCE

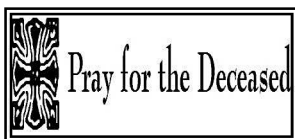

Everyday Stewardship

Art Buchwald, the longtime humorist for the Washington Post who died in 2007 is credited with saying "The best things in life aren't things." As Christians, we know this statement to be true. Certainly the best things in our lives are not those items that money can buy or things we can create in the material world. Faith, hope and love are more precious than anything we can see with our eyes. Yet as humans we often find ourselves longing for the very things that we claim are not nearly as valuable. We lose sight of what is real and true.

Paul wrote in the fourth chapter of his Letter to the Philippians that he has experienced both living with abundance and then with very little. Regardless of what we have in terms of worldly goods, Paul reminds us that God provides for all our needs. God may not provide for our wants but he does give us what we need.

The flesh seeks what it wants but the spirit seeks what it needs. In a stewardship way of life we must always remind ourselves that true wealth never comes from material possessions and money. True wealth comes from the love we share, the faith we develop and the hope we bring to others. The best things in life aren't free though. They require work, commitment and fortitude. We need to cultivate these things daily. If we are serious about living life in this way, we will find that when our days on this earth are through we really had it all. -

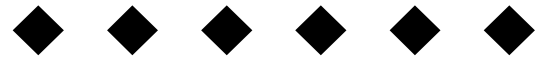

This transfer ensures that your scheduled transactions will continue to be received by the parish as scheduled. The security of your personal information is important. If you want to make any changes to your account, WeShare requires a one-time security verification to provide you access.

To successfully complete the verification process you will need:

- Your ParishPay User Name
- Last four digits of the bank account or credit card

And one of the following two options:

The email you used to register with ParishPay

A collection name and a specific amount donated in the last six months.

Once verification is complete, you will receive a confirmation email with a link to our new WeShare site.

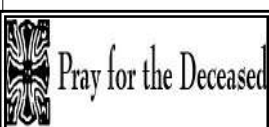

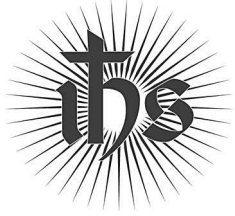
