Our Parish Celebrates The Rite of Acceptance and Welcome

On Sunday October 19, 2014 at the 12 Noon Mass our parish celebrates the Rite of Acceptance and Welcome of the candidates presently in the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). We joyfully accept into our parish community those inquirers who desire to be baptized into our Christian faith at the Easter Vigil. They are **Kiyoharu Goto and Julie Torres**. They are signed on their senses with the Sign of the Cross so that Christ will strengthen them with the sign of His love.

We also welcome those who are already baptized and will complete their sacraments of initiation—Confirmation and First Eucharist—at the Easter Vigil. They are **Renee Longo, Reina Torres and Faith Underwood**.

All parishioners are encouraged to join in this Rite of Acceptance and Welcome. The RCIA inquirers as of yet not baptized officially enter the period of the Catechumenate, several months of intense preparation. Those already baptized continue the process of “continuing conversion.”

We congratulate all of them in taking this important step within their faith journey. They are as much a blessing for our parish as a newborn is to a family! We praise and thank God for the gift of growth and increase. The RCIA members and team ask all our parishioners to keep us in prayer as we continue with you our journey of faith in Jesus Christ.
