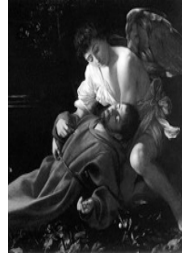

CELEBRATING FRANCIS OF ASSISI



Thursday, October 4, is the feast of Saint Francis. In recognition of our Franciscan heritage here at Holy Name we will transfer the feast to the weekend of October 6 – 7 to allow for greater participation in our festivities.

The *Transitus*, a prayer service that commemorates the passing of Saint Francis, will be celebrated at St. Francis of Assisi Church on Wednesday, October 3 at 7:30 P.M. The Church is located at 135 West 31st Street (Between 6th and 7th Avenues). All are welcome to participate with Franciscans from around the city.

Our parish celebration of the feast will begin with a BLESSING OF ANIMALS on Saturday, October 6 at 12:00 noon on the front steps of the Church. Our Saturday evening vigil Mass as well as all of our liturgies on Sunday, October 7 will be festive celebrations of Francis.

Open House New York (OHNY) will offer a “Spires on Amsterdam” tour on **Saturday, October 6, 2012. Holy Name Church will be open to the public from 10:00am to 12:00 pm and from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm.** Holy Name Parishioners are all invited. There is no charge for the visit and the tour, come and enjoy the art and the treasures of our Church and bring your friends.
