Holy Name of Jesus Church is sponsoring a new service for those who may be interested in the opportunity to meet with a person trained in Spiritual Direction. You may ask "WHAT IS SPIRITUAL DIRECTION?" Spiritual Direction encourages you to explore a closer relationship with God. Because of the busyness of our lives in the "city that never sleeps", many people may find it difficult to notice God's action in their daily affairs.

In Spiritual Direction, you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life. Gradually, as you focus and take the time to contemplate, you may begin to recognize God's presence and grace. You may come to realize how His spirit is truly with you every day and everywhere. You will discover that God has been waiting for you to seek this closer relationship. Spiritual Direction is really not about being "directed." Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God.

Sister Mary Petrosky, FMM, a member of our parish, and an experienced spiritual director holds a MSW from St. Louis U. and a MA in Systematic Theology from Jesuit School of Theology in Berkeley, Ca. She has had many years experience in the fields of social work/counseling and more recently in spiritual direction.
